Project Specifics

This new 3-storey building is the hospital's newly classified acute care centre with a mixture of paediatric, stroke care, rehabilitation, and elderly care services. Specialist facilities include rehab gyms, a therapy kitchen and assisted ensuite bathrooms to accommodate patients that often may have dementia or other brain injuries. Within the ground floor are 2 number isolation wards which are serviced by independent systems.

Technical Characteristics

The temporary ward buildings are to support the longer-term development of the Hospital Site. The building services works were valued at £6,200,000.00 and were successfully completed over a 10-month program in line with the clients' initial expectations. Gallant Building Services worked closely with the Western Building Solutions on the logistics of an operational hospital and the consultants, Bailey Partnership, to develop the services to both be compliant with the HTMs and to ensure that the requirements of the Trust together with their incumbents were adhered to.

Project Successes

Secured via the NHS Shared Business Services framework, this project provided a bespoke Multi-Storey Modular Ward Building for the Hillingdon Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. Built in a 3-storey arrangement, the building provides acute care with pediatric, stroke, rehabilitation, and elderly care services. Individual facilities included rehab gym, therapy kitchen and assisted ensuite bathrooms to accommodate dementia and brain injury patients. The scope of works encompassed £6m of services which were successfully delivered over a 10-month program in line with the client's initial expectations. Services encompassed all mechanical, electrical, and public health services including extending the primary steam and condense supply.
