B&Q has recently entered into a new pre-lease agreement for a 430,000 square foot facility focused on achieving net-zero carbon emissions in its construction. Tritax Symmetry, the logistics development arm of Tritax Big Box REIT plc, has secured a 15-year lease with B&Q for this purpose-built facility at Symmetry Park, a prominent industrial and distribution complex situated near the border of North Nottinghamshire and South Yorkshire.

Technical Characteristics



There are multiple units within the project. The site encompasses 54 acres and has received thorough planning approval for a total of 721,000 square feet allocated for B8 usage.
